

Hard Rocker 5.9 on Inner Outlet in CSP

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Hardrocker is an excellent Dennis Horning route that takes a mixed line of 4 bolts and clean gear to the summit of Outer Outlet. The clean gear on the route is good but the bolts were old ¼ button heads and ¼ self drill bolts. We replaced three bolts on the route and the anchors. The last bolt on the route was just beneath a good horizontal that had multiple options for gear placements with modern cams. We did not replace this bolt with BHCC hardware, but left the bolt for historic value since you can place good gear right above it. We need to return to finish patching the holes and removing a ¼ stud that snapped. We got caught in a downpour /electrical storm and had to bail.

Anchors:

Previous Hardware:

5/16 self drill bolts (non stainless) x2

Stainless Metolius Hangers x2

Tied webbing and 1 non stainless quick link

BHCC Hardware Installed:

Fixe Triplex Bolt (X2)

Petzl Coeur Hanger

Fixe Top Hanger

8mm Stainless Chain links (5 links...4 on anchor plus 1 for cutting)

8mm Stainless Quick Links (x3)

Hardware on the Route:

Previous Hardware

1st bolt- ¼ self drill and angle iron hanger

2nd and 3rd bolts- ¼ threaded button head with non stainless SMC hangers

4th bolt was not removed

BHCC Hardware Installed:

Fixe Triplex Bolt (x3)

Petzl Coeur Hanger (x3)
